## Details for grading in CHORUS:

- 1.Attendance: punctuality & participation.
- 2.Preparedness: folder, pencils (not pens), seating.
- 3.Musicianship: energy and vitality in the tone, style perceptions, appropriate vowel formations, precise consonant articulations, pitch accuracy.
- **4.Attitude:** willingness, energy, vitality, applying past knowledge, involvement/responsiveness, ability to decrease impulsivity.
- 5. Pro-Activity: actively participating vs. Passivity.
- 6.Posture/Breathing: knowledge/demonstration of proper placement of feet/legs, head, chest, music/arms/hands/eyes/back/neck.
- 7.Procedures: rules, attention, stopping time, tardiness, negative behaviors.
- **8.Cooperation:** positive attributes, individual responsibilities, responsibilities to the group.
- 9. Comprehension: demonstration of basic knowledge
- 10.Application: applying past knowledge to activities, tests, etc.
- 11.Analysis/Synthesis: ability to follow process in breaking down and accomplishing details of a task and then placing them into the whole
- 12.Risk Taking Practice: willingness/ability to assert oneself without risk of ridicule, embarrassment, etc., self-confidence without arrogance or domination
- 13.Persistence: demonstration of confidence in self and others to accomplish goals, ability to tackle a problem from a new perspective when faced with defeats, learning to FAIL FORWARD, learning to laugh at mistakes (not others) and proceed NOT TO BE ENTERTAINED BY THEM!

## Chorus: This course will-

- 1. Introduce appropriate music theory.
- 2. Establish within the student self-confidence in sight-reading.
- 3. Establish a sound set of performance rules.
- 4. Establish basic confidence in general style interpretation.
- 5. Establish positive enthusiasm towards musical expression.
- 6. Stimulate the desire for further, more in depth study of the choral art.
- 7. Establish sound musical skills and knowledge suitable for musical training beyond the high school level.
