GRADUATION GUIDELINES:

Cape Fear High School's annual graduation is considered to be a major performance for the choral students. Chorus members must earn the right to perform in the ceremony and, like any other choral event, is only open to current choral members. This right is earned through the following:

- 1. Perfect attendance at all required rehearsals and /or performances during the year's activities, or SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF ALL APPROPRIATE MAKE-UP WORK .*
- 2. A 95 average of all grades in participation. These grades will include virtually ALL BEHAVIOR:
 - a) In class, daily;
 - b) At each and every performance/required rehearsal;
 - c) On every field trip.
- 3. The consistent demonstration of a POSITIVE ATTITUDE.*
- 4. The consistent obedience to all school rules, whether or not the student happens to agree with them. This applies to citizenship in the total school environment, field trips, and activities directly concerning the choral group(s) in which the student is enrolled.

Students who habitually visit I.D.E.A.L., chew gum, are not prepared for class, cause or participate in physical fights, demonstrate disrespect*, etc., should not expect to participate in nor attend graduation.

* Satisfactory completion of make-up work, Positive Attitude, and disrespect will be defined and determined exclusively by Mr. Britt.

The student will be notified at least three weeks prior to graduation, should this be the case.
