Home Practice

As of the Spring 2013 semester, students enrolled in Proficient and Advanced Chorus will be required to practice at home those things we practice in class. This can include repertoire, sight reading, rhythmic exercises, interval ear training, or any other thing(s) that pertain to music, chorus, or the curriculum. Because of this new requirement, it is imperative that each student have access to the internet away from school (home, cell phone, library, etc.). The following will apply for the remainder of the Fall 2019 semester starting September 03, 2019:

<u>Proficient</u>: you are to do home practice for an average of seventy-five (75) minutes per week (15 min. per day) and will be collected on Tuesdays. Your grade will based upon the amount of minutes you practice during a five (5) day school week. Late practice logs will result in the subtraction of three (3) points per day late. **Practice logs that are late a week (7 days) or more will not be accepted**. Practice should be spread out across five (5) days and should not be completed in less than five days.

Advanced: you are to do home practice for an average one hundred (100) minutes per week (20 min. per day) and will be collected on Tuesdays. Your grade will based upon the amount of minutes you practice during a five (5) day school week. Late practice logs will result in the subtraction of three (3) points per day late. Practice logs that are late a week (7 days) or more will not be accepted. Practice should be spread out across five (5) days and should not be completed is less than five days.
