Choral Performance Make-up Assignment

From time to time we all have to miss a performance. In this class, our performances make up for thirty percent of your grade. I do not mind you missing a performance, if you tell me in advance. I frown upon you telling me that you will be there and then you don't show. Also, if you miss a performance you must make it up (whether you have previously told me or not). Remember that there are certain excuses that are acceptable for missing a performance.

Make-Up Assignment

Your make-up assignment will be to schedule an appointment with Mr. Britt after school to sing your part by yourself. Your part does not necessarily need to be sung with accompaniment, but rather could be sung acapella. If in the event that the director is limited in their abilities to provide accompaniment(s), the student will sing their part acapella. If the student would like to sing their part to an accompaniment that cannot be provided by the director, it is understood that it is the **student's** responsibility to provide an accompanist and for possible payment of that accompanist. The repertoire to be sung during this make-up session will be the same repertoire pertaining to the missed performance. There will be no substitutions or deletions of the number of pieces sung. Since you know of your performances ahead of time, **you will** have one week to complete this assignment. Late assignments will altered five (5) point per each day late.
